

JA Connect Learning Pathways Access Instructions

This document outlines how to access Release 1.0 of JA Connect Learning Pathways.

General Requirements

- Hardware
 - Resolution: 1024x768 or greater
 - Table / iPad and up (horizontal)
 - Mobile devices (cell phones) will work, but the pages may not render well.
- Operating System
 - Mac version Yosemite or newer
 - Windows 7 or newer
 - Support for CORS
- Browser
 - Modern browsers (Chrome, Edge, Firefox, Safari)
 - Support for CORS
 - Cookies enabled

1. Login credentials are required to access the self-guided student activities.
2. JASA manages access for staff, educators, volunteers, and students. If a user is valid in JASA, but not correctly setup in UMS, they get a sign in-OIDC error.
 - a. User credentials are set up in the UMS. Users, including students, can be added using their preferred email address and they will manager their own password.
 - b. Student users may be set up in the UMS utilizing a generic username and password.
 - c. Students must be also be enrolled in a JA program to access JA Connect Learning Pathways content.
3. Users can access Resources and the JA Digital Career Book sections of JA Connect without having login credentials.
